WHAT WE DO

Project Mona's House was founded in 2017. We exist to shed light on the hidden crime of Human Trafficking, restore those who have been victimized, and prevent it from ever happening again.

Women are invited in as victims, transformed into survivors, and by the time they leave... THEY ARE OVERCOMERS.

We've been able achieve our results through the following initiatives:



MONA'S HOUSE

Our long-term, residential facility that offers holistic healing for victims of human trafficking in all 50 states.



MONA'S GROUP

Group therapy and network of support for victims of human trafficking or women who have been victimized within the sex industry.



MONA'S OUTREACH
